NON-EMBEDDED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bilingual Dictionary- for ELA performance task full-writes; word-to-word dual language dictionary • Color Contrast- available for students with the Print on Demand accommodation • Color Overlay- available for students with the Print on Demand accommodation • Magnification- requires assistive technology • Noise Buffers • Read Aloud- not available for reading passages • Scribe- for non-writing items and math items only • Separate Setting • Translated Test Directions- PDF of directions translated in each of the languages currently supported • Translations (Glossary)- for math items only 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Abacus • Alternate Response Options (adapted keyboards, StickyKeys, MouseKeys, touch screen, switches) • Calculator- for calculator allowed items only; for students with visual impairments who are unable to use the embedded calculator (Braille or talking calculator) • Multiplication Table- for math items beginning in grade 4; not allowed for grade 3; paper-based single digit (1-9) • Print on Demand- very small percentage of students should need this accommodation; must contact district coordinator to submit request for Caltac to set (items) • Read Aloud- for ELA reading passages; appropriate for only 1-2% of students with disabilities • Scribe- for ELA writing only • Speech-to-Text- requires assistive technology device with voice recognition software
